It is possible to connect two 36 cell panels in series and then parallel them with a 72 cell panel. But you would want the combined voltages of the two 36 cell panels to match that of the 72 cell panel, as close as possible.

For example, if you installed 5 solar panels in series – with each solar panel rated at 12 volts and 5 amps – you'd still have 5 amps but a full 60 volts.
