

Does solar nuclear power generation produce radiation



Overview

The short answer is no, solar panels do not emit harmful ionizing radiation. They primarily generate electricity by converting sunlight into direct current (DC) electricity, a process that does not involve radioactive materials or processes. The fear surrounding solar panels and radiation often stems from a misunderstanding of what radiation actually is and. Nuclear energy is a form of energy released from the nucleus, the core of atoms, made up of protons and neutrons. This source of energy can be produced in two ways: fission – when nuclei of atoms split into several parts – or fusion – when nuclei fuse together. Presently, the vast majority of electricity from nuclear power is produced by nuclear fission of uranium and plutonium in nuclear.
