The test temperature represents the average temperature during the solar peak hours of the spring and autumn in the continental United States. For example, a solar panel with 20% efficiency and an area of 1 m² produces 200 kWh/yr under Standard Test Conditions while exposed to 1000 W/m² for 2. Solar panels absorb sunlight for longer periods/day, but solar irradiance is less than 1000 W/m² for most of the day. More specifically, a system with a capacity of 6 kW can produce approximately 30 kWh in a day under ideal circumstances.
